<u>Christmas Trees</u>: please don't burn them, take them to the Ross recycling centre. You can wrap them in an old sheet so that your car doesn't become full of needles.

OR buy a potted tree that you can reuse again and again (might need to repot it) or get creative and use a fallen tree branch?





And finally....

<u>Cans and tins</u>: As we operate 'single stream' recycling here in Herefordshire (one bin for all recycling), cans should not be (completely) flattened or the machine may not recognise them, and then the next destination is landfill. Tins can be flattened as they are magnetic, and so be identified by the.... magnets. Get it?

We will issue a follow up newsletter in the near future on recycling items that will not go in your green trolley bin or the recycling centre. You will be amazed at what can be recycled, and we intend to make it very easy to do that with a community recycling project.
